Board positions are held for a period of three years. Any board members appointed by the board throughout the year must then be elected by the homeowners at the next Annual Meeting.

Being a member of the Treehill Park Board of Directors is a great opportunity to make a positive contribution to our Association — however participation on the Board involves a commitment of time and energy. As a Board member you will need to attend 12 meetings per year. We currently meet on the last Wednesday of the month at 6:30 pm. Meetings usually run one hour, but occasionally end earlier or later than that.

Board members receive no compensation or special privileges for serving on the board. However, since board members are tasked with rule enforcement, they are expected to abide by the rules and set a good example in deck and patio appearance, leashing and picking up after pets, abiding by parking regulations, and keeping the areas around their units free of litter and debris.

Board members may be asked to attend periodic Condominium Association training sessions and will be reimbursed for these expenses. Board members may also be asked to participate on various committees that are formed to plan the budget, write resolutions, or to work on other special projects. From time-to-time some of our Board Members may need to contact vendors to obtain information or quotes on various projects. Once in a while we also meet with vendors on our property to conduct walkthroughs regarding special projects.
